It's time to get your Sprinkler System up and running!

Depending on your type of sprinkler system and the components involved, your startup process may require different steps – but the typical steps of a sprinkler start-up are:

- **Checking Your System Controllers:** It's important to clean away debris, check for repairs and replace your controller batteries, if necessary.
- Checking Sprinkler Heads and Nozzles: Clean up dirt, check for clogs, clear away debris and check for damage to your nozzles and sprinkler heads before start-up.
- **Inspecting Valves and Pipes:** Look for leaks or signs of damage in your aboveground hardware before opening up your valves. You should turn on your system slowly to introduce water without causing pressure surges.
- **Setting Timers:** Program your system's timers to ensure your watering occurs on a set schedule.

Backflow Testing – What is it?


The majority of backflow assemblies include a check valve, a set of springs, and occasionally a relief valve. Each of these mechanical internal components must be tested annually and maintained, if necessary. During a backflow test, the assembly is pressurized and then each part is isolated to ensure it is operating at an acceptable level. The check valves must hold a minimum pressure to pass the inspection, and the relief valves must open before a certain pressure differential is reached. Repairs and possible replacement must be performed if minimum standards are not met.

Is testing required?

Yes, state regulations require all backflow prevention devices to be tested annually.
